Programme of Gyanalok 2020-21

1: Education Awareness

In the Year 2020-21, Gyanalok organized three Education awareness Programme one each in Primary Karadapalla, Haja ME school, Gambharimunda high school, in Gambharimunda. Additionally, one career counselling programme was also organized in the Patita Paban Bani Mandir, Gambharimunda high school with the help on an expert from National Institute of Science Education and Research (NISER), Khordha to guide the career path of 10th class students. Furthermore, education awareness meeting was conducted among the parents/guardian of the school children. Key aspects focused under awareness and counselling:



- ✓ Meeting with intellectual parents
- ✓ Sharing idea with leaders
- ✓ Motivating students through felicitation
- ✓ Encourage the drop outs for back to schools

In the three-education awareness programme more than 500 students participated and were sensitized about importance of education in career and character building. Similarly, in the parent/guardian counselling meeting more than 63 responsible parents participated. Additionally, in the career counselling programme for 10th students more than 100 students participated and learned about modern career prospects.

2: Academic Competitions & Prize Distribution

Competition in our education system is a must in order to bring out the best in a student. It helps students

to develop their creativity and their skill sets. It also boosts their self-esteem, motivates them to become productive and makes them mentally strong. In the Gyanalok organized vear 2020-21, different competitions under the theme "Gigyansa" (Essay Competition, Debate, Quiz and Drawing) in PPBM, Gambharimunda High School, Haja Primary school and Karadapalla primary school. In all three competitions a total 174 students Participated of which 42 students were awarded with prize and certificate.



3: Monetary support for education

In the year 2020-21, total seven poor and needy students were given monetary support for their further education. The supported students are continuing their study Godavarish in Mahavidyalaya, Banapur, Parsuram Mahavidyalaya, Gambharimunda and Nachuni Mahavidyalaya, Nachuni. Additionally, Gyanalok also supported for the second-year readmission and form fill-up cost of 06 students who were provided with monetary support in the previous year (2019-20).



4: Parents/Guardian Meeting

To educate the children, creation of awareness on value of education among the parents/guardians of the children is highly important. For enhancing quality education and enroll all children in school Gyanalok organizes education awanress meeting among parents/guardian. One such meeting was conducted in the Patita Paban Bani Mandir, Gambharimunda high school. More than 200 parents/guardian attended the meeting. Various issues faced by the parents and how to mitigate the challenges were discussed with the help of experts present in the meeting.
